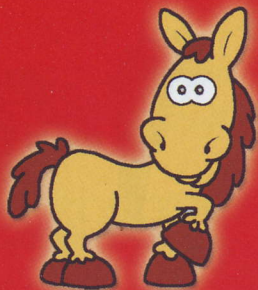


The Silver Horse
